
## FIRST TIME INSTALLATION

- Please read instructions carefully before installation.
- Check the contents of kit. Each LockNLoad RuggedLine has the last four digits of the kit's part number lasered in. Contact your YAKIMA dealer if any parts appear missing, incorrect or damaged.
- Clean your roof thoroughly prior to fitting the LockNLoad RuggedLine.
- Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.




#### **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- 10 mm Socket Wrench
- 13 mm Spanner
- Trim Removal Tool
- 10 mm Breaker Bar (optional)
- Rattle Gun (optional)


## **REMOVING FIXED POINT COVERS (BARE ROOF ONLY)**

#### REMOVE FIXED POINT HARDWARE.

If your vehicle is not fitted with factory roof rails, remove all fixed-point covers.

Remove bolts, washers and brackets from the vehicle's fixed points.



#### **REFIT FIXED POINT.**

You will need to fit the 2nd point bracket (on the roof not the rail) back into the 1st fixed point to stop water entering roof.

Move 2nd bracket to 1st



Store removed hardware away in a safe place.



## **REMOVING FACTORY RAISED ROOF RAILS**





# UNCLIP PLASTIC RAIL COVERS.

Using an appropriate trim removal tool, release the plastic rail end covers by carefully levering the trim removal tool downwards and squeezing the covers until the outer clips release.












REMOVE COVER HARDWARE. Remove exposed hardware using a 10 mm socket wrench or breaker bar. Complete steps 1a - 3 for front and rear covers and repeat on opposite side of vehicle. Store removed hardware away in a safe place. NOTE - A rattle gun may be required if the factory Loctite is too difficult to break loose. When loosening fasteners, switch between them to drop tension progressively. If not, the nutplate inside the roof cavity may come loose.








#### MOUNTING RUGGEDLINE




#### **AFFIX FOAM** ADHESIVE.

Apply foam adhesive over all 12 plastic tubes in the vehicle's mounting holes, with the adhesive side to vehicle.




## APPLY SILICONE SEALANT.

Liberally apply the supplied silicone sealant to the inside surface and on top of each hole on one side of vehicle.



## POSITION RUGGEDLINE ON VEHICLE ROOF.

Referring to the left-right orientation on top of each RuggedLine, carefully place one side of the RuggedLine onto vehicle roof as shown. Line up the mounting holes on the bottom tabs to those exposed on the roof. The tabs are to face in towards the vehicle.





#### ASSEMBLE RUGGEDLINE HARDWARE.

Assemble the M8 x 30 mm socket head cap screw, M8 spring washer and washer as shown and place into mounting holes on bottom tabs of RuggedLine. Ensure hardware and holes align with the holes on roof.



### TIGHTEN RUGGEDLINE HARDWARE.

Using the 6 mm T-handle ball end allen key, and avoiding damage to the powder coat, start to carefully secure the RuggedLine by tightening the M8 socket head cap screws to 7 Nm into the mounting holes in roof.





#### REPEAT STEPS TO OPPOSITE SIDE.

Repeat steps 2-5 on page 5 for securing the opposite side RuggedLine.

Ensure both RuggedLine are securely positioned on vehicle roof. Check each screw is secure before proceeding to install LockNLoad platform to RuggedLine.






#### PIVOT BRACKET ASSEMBLIES.

Retain the 6 mm T-handle ball end allen key and not yet installed pivot brackets, M8 x 20 mm socket head cap screws, M8 nyloc nuts and M8 washers.



These components will be required for mounting your LockNLoad platform to your newly installed RuggedLine
